Methodist University - MASTER OF JUSTICE ADMINISTRATION

Justice agency administrators in North Carolina have experienced some of the greatest challenges in the past few years. The Master of Justice Administration provides a solid foundation to aid administrators of justice agencies to meet the challenges before them, and rise to meet the ever-changing needs of the justice system. Through a core of traditional justice administration courses, a focus on critical thinking, problem-based learning, and practical application, students will develop the critical skills necessary to be effective future leaders. In addition, the curriculum prepares graduates to teach at the community college and in some cases the university level. The program combines online classes with weekend residencies at the Salemburg or Edneyville N.C. Justice Academy campuses. The deadline for admission in the 2015 Fall Semester is July 15, 2015.

Single License Plate Renewal Sticker – Effective 5/26/15

Per the General Assembly of North Carolina through Session Law 2014-108 House Bill 272, effective May 26, 2015, the Division began issuing a single-registration renewal sticker. The single-registration renewal sticker is grey in color. The expiring month and year is printed on the sticker, along with the plate number. The expiring month and year is printed above the plate number on the sticker. This eliminates the need for a month sticker. The “single sticker” is required to be placed on the upper right-hand side of the license plate.
