

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING:

In order to attend our five (5) day Instructor certification program, one must be an active Law Enforcement professional or a North Carolina Criminal Justice Instructor. At the inception of the 5 day program, the attendee will sign a waiver (a legal and binding document) indicating their understanding and agreement with the terms that after successful completion of the program, the attendee will be certified to teach the Verbal Judo program only to members of the agency/department/institution with which they are currently employed. If they separate from their sponsoring agency, their certificate will be invalid until such time as the certified trainer finds employment with another Law Enforcement Agency or Criminal Justice Institution. The certification is valid for 3 years from date of issuance, after which time the member must attend a re-certification program offered by the Verbal Judo Institute if they wish to remain certified.
