### **Use of Force Simulators**

Our two Use of Force Simulators – one for each campus – have arrived! They will be used to introduce officers to a variety of situations where they will have to use past training, along with information provided during classroom instruction, to address confrontational individuals. A key component of the instruction will also involve a report writing segment, with strong emphasis on articulation and documentation, to demonstrate that the level of force used was consistent with General Statute and current case law.
