#### **IMI Florida and NCJA**

IMI Florida Academy is pleased to offer state-of-the-art training to law enforcement through NCJA. This course takes students through major milestones that contributed to the evolving Israeli Security Concept, the lessons learned, and how these lessons have been implemented. Students will be introduced to fundamentals that underlie the Israeli Security Concept, as well as prevention methods and immediate tactical response.

The Israeli active shooter response is based on the single fighter concept, which embodies striving to engage and violence of action. Students are trained to engage an assailant with aggression, determination, speed and precision. During this course students will learn and practice Israel's active incident response style and tactics.

#### **Who Should Attend this Course**

The course is restricted to active duty law enforcement, military, or security personnel who are involved in executing security tasks, and threat assessment. Participants must be capable of engaging in physically rigorous exercise without medical restriction.

#### **Course Coordinator:** Haim Geri

Haim Geri, Academic Dean of IMI Florida Academy, will conduct the course. Previously, he served in the Israel Defense Forces as Company Commander and Assistant Chief of Staff for Operations in charge of the northern border. Upon discharge at the rank of Captain, Mr. Geri joined the General Security Services (GSS) of Israel where he served as Chief of Security for Israeli embassies in Latin America and Switzerland. He also served as an Air Marshall for El Al Airlines. Later, he joined the GSS Counter-Terror Academy to train students in aviation, maritime, critical infrastructure, and executive protection tactics. Mr. Geri brings decades of experience in counter-terrorism, SWAT, and firearms training to a new generation of professionals. In addition to Mr. Geri, a second senior instructor from Israel will be present to assist throughout the three days of training.

**Length of Course:** 3 Days (0900 to 1700)

**Cost:** \$600

**Course Goals:**

- To promote the mentality to engage autonomously and from a tactically disadvantaged position
- To enhance the single fighter technical and tactical skills to survive the attack and eliminate threats with precision and speed

**Course Objectives:**

At the end of this course, participants will be able to achieve the following objectives in accordance with the information presented during the instructional period:

- Identify critical threat indicators prior to an active incident, when possible, to prevent it from occurring.
- Demonstrate weapons proficiency and Krav Maga skills.
- Operate under high levels of stress with fortitude and aggressiveness appropriate to the given situation and within the confines of the law.
- Respond as a single operative and demonstrate the tactics necessary to successfully neutralize the threat.

**Methodologies:**

This course employs lecture, discussion, demonstrations, practical and surprise exercises

**Course Requirements:**

100% Attendance. Successfully complete all practical exercises, including 70% of speed / accuracy shooting test

Students must bring with them:

- Appropriate training attire
- Eye & ear protection
- Pistol + 3 Magazines
- Holster suitable for a rapid draw
- Magazine pouch for two magazines
- 700 pistol rounds
